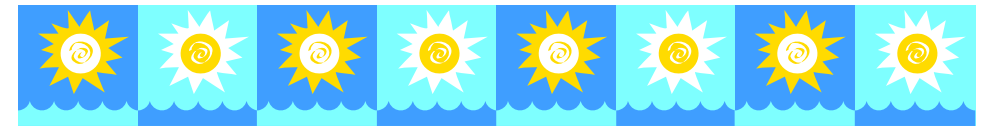

“Investigation Station”

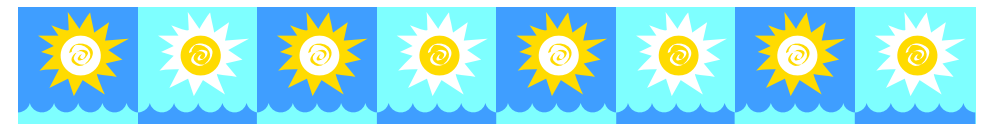
Rising 5th through Rising 8th Graders

“SUMMER CARE”

“*Summer Care*” is for preschool (age 2 by January 1, 2010 and **potty trained**) through rising 4th graders. “*Summer Care*” will open at 8:30 a.m. and will close at 4:30 p.m. **Children must pack their lunch and two (2) snacks!** Summer Care has three sub groups by age: Preschool—Pre-Kindergarten, Rising Junior Kindergarten—Rising Kindergarten, and Rising 1st—Rising 4th grades:

Rising Preschool through Rising Pre-Kindergarten

Your children will be participating in a number of fun filled activities: e.g. Water Play, Arts & Crafts, Guest Speakers/Special Events, Computer Time, Library Time, Gym Time and fun outside. All the activities happen here on campus.

- **Option #1 Full Day:**

This option allows your child(ren) to stay the whole day. With this option your child(ren) will have a rest period after lunch, so you will need to pack a crib sheet and blanket along with a lunch.

- **Option #2 Half Day:**

This option will have you picking your child(ren) up by 12:30, following a lunch packed by you.

Rising Junior Kindergarten through Rising Kindergarten

Your children will be participating in a number of fun filled activities: e.g. Water Play, Arts & Crafts, Guest Speakers/Special Events, Computer Time, Library Time, Gym Time and fun outside. All the activities happen here on campus.

Rising 1st Grade through Rising 4th Grade

This group is designed for your children to have a little more independence than younger ones. On campus and like the younger ones as described above, they will be participating in a number of activities: Arts & Crafts, Guest Speakers/Special Events, Computer Time, Library Time, Gym Time and fun outside. But unlike the younger ones, they will also have off-campus activities: some on a regular basis—e.g. Roller Skating, Swimming and Hiking—and some one time—e.g. bowling, along with a trip to a baseball game, a carnival, and caverns.



“INVESTIGATION STATION”

“*Investigation Station*” is for rising 5th graders through 8th graders. Investigation Station will open at 8:30 a.m. and will close at 4:30 p.m. “*Investigation Station*” is an exciting program designed to include a wide variety of activities involving crafts, arts, games, and physical exercise programs as well as creative endeavors. Through daily activities, field trips, and projects, students will have a well-balanced summer program that they will enjoy. Along with swimming, hiking, field trips, and art projects, students will enjoy a season of fun. Obviously some of these activities will be off-campus. In all, the program is open to students of all abilities and interests.

For both programs PLEASE remember to apply sunscreen to your children before they come in the mornings!

Also for both programs, please be sure to mark all your child’s belongings with first and last names!

In both programs students who need to arrive before 8:30 a.m. or leave after 4:30 p.m. may come to Before/After Care, which runs from 7:30-8:30 a.m. and from 4:30-5:30 p.m. Unlike “*Summer Care*” and “*Investigation Station*”, Before/After Care is simply unstructured, though supervised, childcare. There is an extra charge for this service, billed on the half-hour.

Outstanding Activities for Students In the Summer

The cost of the program is as follows:

Registration, t-shirt and supply fee: \$50.00/each child
Late Registration fee (after May 7th): \$55.00/each child

Multiple Child Discount (available for weekly rate only) = \$25 for 2nd child per week for whole day, \$35 per week for 3rd child.

Beginning with Rising 1st Grades there will be additional field trip fees for the one-time only trips, e.g. bowling; the Carnival at Brandy Station; visiting a caverns, a trip to a baseball game, etc.

Note that the activity fees do not include "Out to Lunch" opportunities in the Investigation Station program.

Last, Before & After Care (i.e. from 7:30-8:30 a.m. and 4:30-5:30 p.m.) is billed separately at a rate of \$4.50 an hr.

Should your child forget a lunch (or forget lunch money in the case of the IS students on their lunch out day), a lunch will be provided here for which you will be charged.

In order to plan activities and provide adequate staffing, we offer daily and weekly rates over the summer. You will be asked on the registration form to indicate which program you plan to use. **No changes are allowed from daily to weekly option or vice versa once registrations are received.** Weekly participants may have non-paid weeks due to vacation, etc. but must sign up in advance for these. Note as well that weekly participants may NOT split vacation days up between weeks. In choosing the weekly or daily payment option, please circle the weeks or days your child(ren) will be in attendance. **Weekly and daily attendance must be committed to two weeks in advance in order to provide adequate staffing for your child(ren). Failure to do so will result in your being not being allowed to attend those days/weeks.**

OASIS closes at 5:30 each day. Parents of children not picked up by 5:30 p.m. will be charged a late fee of \$1/ per minute payable directly to the OASIS staff members in attendance when your child is picked up.

Children must pack their lunch and 2 daily snacks! IS students will be able to go out to lunch out once a week and will need to bring money to participate.
