- Put your name and grade on the back of both of these entries.
- All submissions will be due by Monday, December 14, 2009.
- Please turn in completed pictures and written summary to your homeroom/classroom teacher.

Judging will take place before and after the Christmas chapel on December 18th. All students, faculty, staff, parents and visitors will be able to view your pictures and written paragraphs which will be displayed in the gym. They will then select the number of their favorite entry. Prizes will be awarded (after you return from break) to the top 3 based upon the number of votes received.
